ACTIVITY: LOCATIONS HUNT, CHAPTER 2 The Aftermath

Look at the three images below. They all show locations from the book as described in Chapter 2. Can you match the location to an extract from the chapter?

- Write a sentence saying where you think each place might be, and why.
- Select a **quote** (a sentence or phrase from the chapter) that seems to match the image.



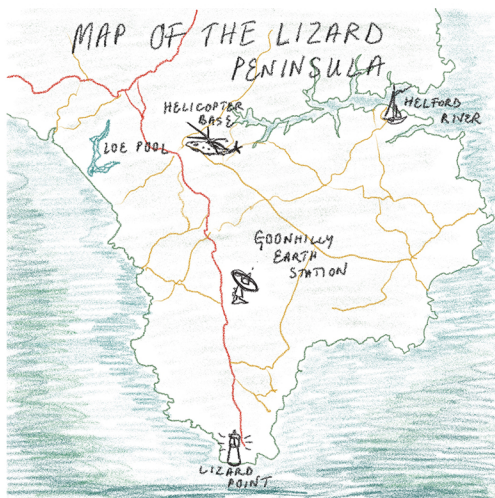


In Chapter 2, Gorran walks from his home in the village to a section of crumbling cliff towards Dollar Cove. Along the way he sees different people doing things. Thoughts drift through his mind about the places he sees.

ACTIVITY: DESIGNING A MAP or A COMIC STRIP BASED ON CHAPTER 2

Write a list of Gorran's movements, e.g. 'buys pasty', 'sees Grace swimming', 'stops to look at beach rubbish' to help you plan.

You can then choose from **either** of the activities below:



The image on the left is a hand-drawn map of the Lizard Peninsula. You are going to create a much smaller illustrated map of Gorran's walk. It will show things that are significant in the story rather than tourist attractions.

Why not use a maps app to enter place names from the story and see if you can map his walk? What do you think is the name of Gorran's village? Draw on or add images to show significant things he sees or does along the way.

Your second choice of task is to create a 3-5 frame comic strip showing a short scene or sequence of events from the chapter.

You can hand-draw this in any combination of frame shapes you like, or you could use an online generator such as www.storyboardthat.com.

Make sure your scene goes from left to right, top to bottom, and try and vary frame size and design. Use captions for speech or bubbles for thoughts. *The example below is real student work!*
